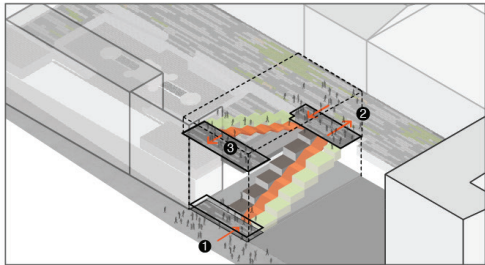
The library is envisioned as a driver to energize the terrace and reestablish it as a vital community focus.

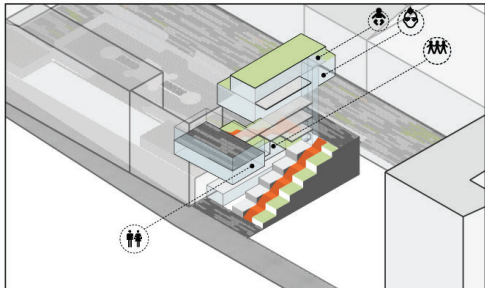
Diverse levels, important axes, and circulation paths are terrace elements that are echoed in the Library.

It RE-CREATES the terrace inside the project, into smaller, more intense plaza spaces. The Library becomes an encapsulation of the terrace.

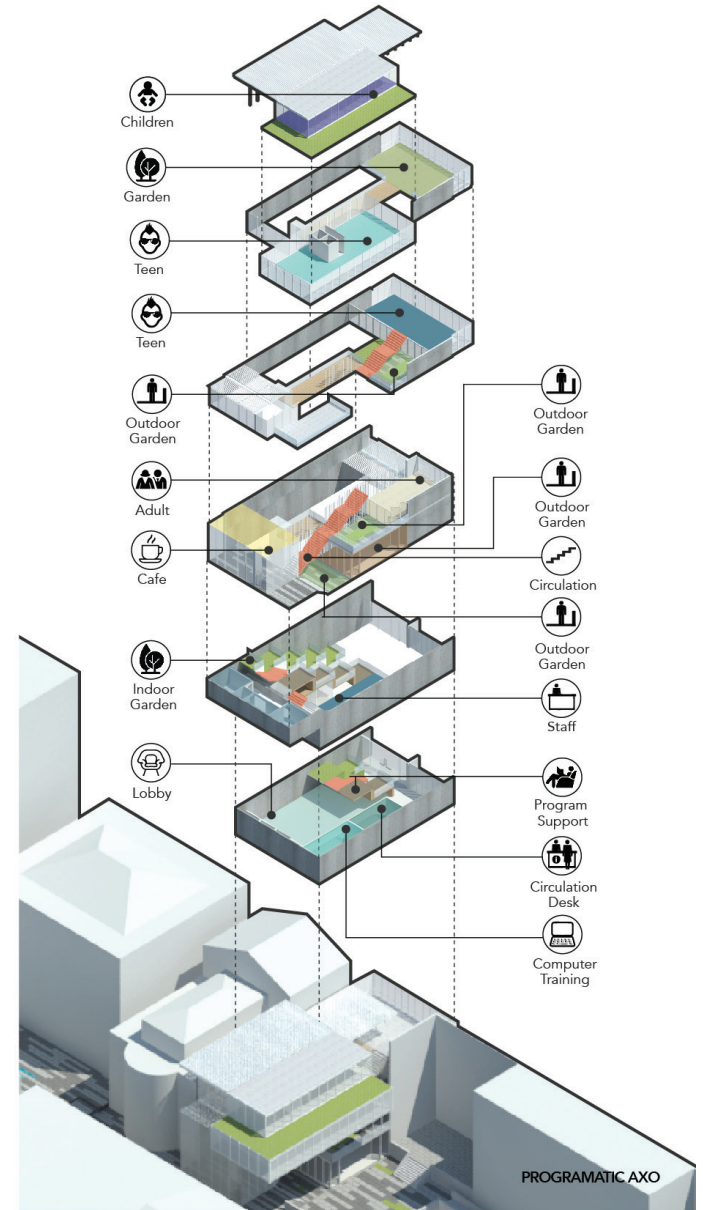

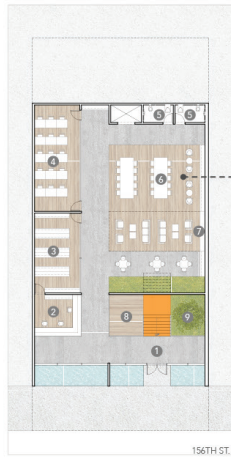
Multiple levels of spatial and programmatic connection serve as a paradigm for community interaction.







The proposal connects three key points: 156th Street, the Terrace and the Roof Garden through a meandering circulation, while creating a direct visual connection.

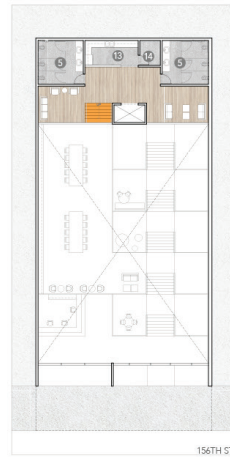

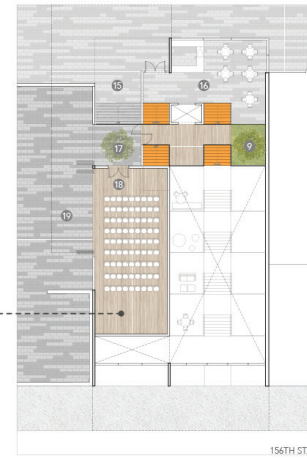

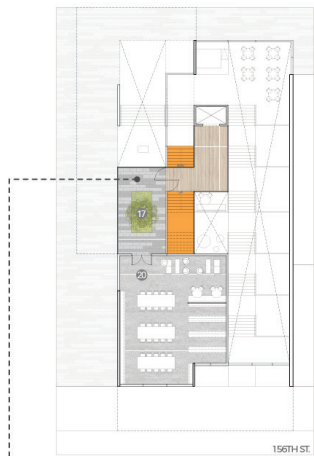

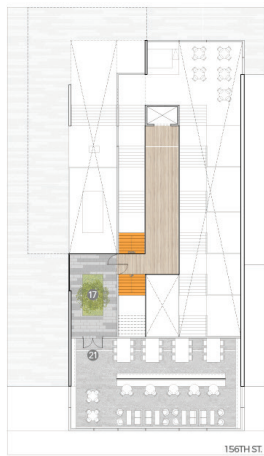

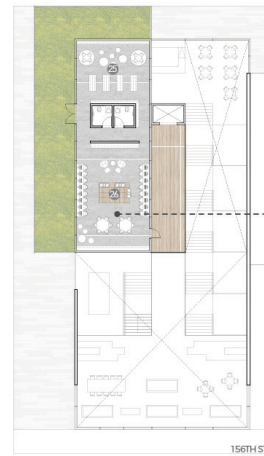
